CODE OF CONDUCT
PARENTS, MEMBERS, RACERS

The objective of this code of conduct is to ensure that KCPRO-EAST OVAL ICE Racing parents and racers are to remain positive and promote good sportsmanship at all times throughout the season. **Racers will not be allowed to race until all parents/step-parents/legal guardians of each racer within KCPRO sign this form.**

I therefore agree:

Parents are responsible for themselves, racers, and spectators accompanying them that they will conduct themselves in a manner that represents good sportsmanship and fair racing at all times. I understand it is my duty to inform my racer/s and spectators accompanying me. Fair racing is defined as the following:

- Be knowledgeable of KCPRO-EAST rules and regulations and abide by them.
 - **You are responsible to read and understand all ISR rules and regulations each season.**
 - A racer is NOT to deliberately cut off or run into other racers during hot laps or races. This includes pushing from behind.
 - Promote good sportsmanship by all members involved and racers.
- Parents and racers must always refrain from foul language and **heated discussions. Officers shall administrate a warning for unnecessary behavior in front of a group and be asked to go somewhere private. Second warning shall be to leave immediately for the remainder of the race day. There is zero tolerance for this behavior in front of children.**
- Parents and racers will be equally representative of good sportsmanship in winning and losing
- Parents and racers will treat all equipment (theirs and others) in the proper manner
- Parents and racers will not show or exhibit derogatory conduct toward any race official before, during or after the race.
- Parents will make sure all racers have proper safety equipment on machines and racers.
- Parents will remember to never ridicule or yell at ones racer or participant for making a mistake or not finishing where they had hoped.

I agree that if I fail to abide by this code of conduct, I will be subject to disciplinary action as follows:

1. Verbal warning by an official-to be recorded by and witnessed by KCPRO officials
2. Written warning- to be recorded by KCPRO officials dated and put on record
3. Parent/Racer Race day suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file.
4. Final- Parental/Racer Season suspension.
