2024 CODE OF CONDUCT

The objective of this code of conduct is to ensure that KCPRO-East guardians and racers remain positive, and promote good sportsmanship at all times throughout the season. Racers will not be allowed to race until ALL legal guardians of each racer within KCPRO-East sign this form.

I/we therefore agree:

Guardians are responsible for ensuring themselves, their racers, and spectators accompanying them conduct themselves in a manner that represents good sportsmanship and fair racing at all times. I/we understand it is our duty to inform those accompanying us of this expectation. Fair racing is defined as the following:

- Be knowledgeable of KCPRO-East rules and regulations and abide by them.
 - o You are responsible to read and understand all ISR rules and regulations each season.
 - o A racer is NOT to deliberately cut off or run into other racers during hot laps or races. This includes pushing from behind.
 - o Promote good sportsmanship by all members involved and racers.
- Guardians and Racers must always refrain from foul language and heated discussions. Officers shall issue a warning for unnecessary behavior in front of a group. A second warning shall be to leave immediately for the remainder of the race day. There is zero tolerance for this behavior in front of children.
- Guardians and racers will be equally representative of good sportsmanship in winning and losing
- Guardians and racers will treat all equipment (theirs and others) in the proper manner
- Guardians and racers will not exhibit derogatory conduct toward any race official before, during or after the race.
- Guardians will make sure all racers have proper safety equipment on machines and racers.
- Guardians will remember to never ridicule or yell at one's racer or participant for making a mistake or not • finishing where they had hoped.

I/we agree that if I/we fail to abide by this code of conduct, I/we will be subject to disciplinary action as follows:

- 1. Verbal warning by a KCPRO officer and to be recorded by and witnessed by a fellow KCPRO officer
- 2. Written warning to be recorded by KCPRO officials dated and put on record with the Secretary
- 3. Guardian/Racer race day suspension written documentation of incident kept on file with the Secretary
- 4. Final Guardian/Racer season suspension
